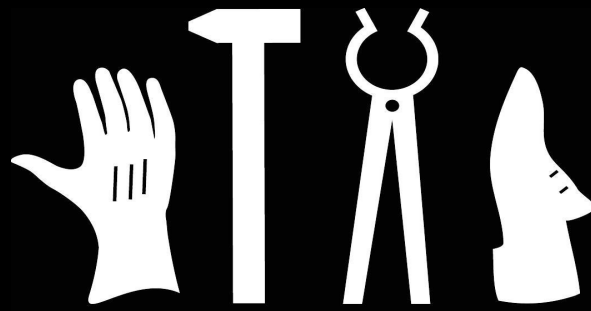

A Little bit of history...

“The Guildhall Tavern (also known in the past as the Bull Hotel and Black Bull) is a Grade 2* listed former coaching inn, which has also served as a posting house and 2 private houses. It dates back to the 17th Century but the oldest part of the building is thought to have a Tudor core. During the famous siege of Denbigh castle during the Civil War (1646), the besieging parliamentary Generals Mytton and Myddleton are said to have established their headquarters here. Perhaps one of the most interesting features of the building is the full height narrow well staircase complete with carved glove motifs which rises from close to the coffee machine. It was at the bottom of this staircase that Denbigh poet legend Twm o'r Nant was rumoured to have sat as a regular until his death in 1810.”
